Practice Overview

Rose accepts instructions across all areas of Chambers' work, having joined Chambers in 2023 following successful completion of her pupillage under the supervision of Christian Howells, Catrin John and Peter Donnison.

In criminal law, Rose regularly appears in the Crown and Magistrates courts across South Wales prosecuting and defending from first hearing through to trial. The plethora of offences that Rose has worked with include cases involving the supply of Class A drugs, violent and sexual offences, assaults against emergency workers and driving offences. She also takes instructions in POCA proceedings. Rose is currently applying to become a CPS Level 2 Prosecutor.

In family law, Rose represents all parties from first hearings through to final hearings in public and private children law. Rose has successfully obtained Non-Molestation, Occupation, and Prohibited Steps orders for clients and has dealt with complicated matters including allocation, internal relocation and guardianship. She regularly handles cases involving serious domestic violence.

Prior to joining chambers, Rose obtained a First Class Bachelor of Science degree in Politics and Sociology from the University of Bristol. She was awarded a major scholarship from The Honourable Society of Gray's Inn and two scholarships from BPP University to study the GDL and the Bar.
